BillTrack

Real-time Legislative Tracker. Every Action of Every Bill. Customized Bill Reports.

Follow your bills in real-time as they travel through Congress from your desktop or mobile devices. It's like a stock ticker, but for legislation—delivering line-item updates on bills important to you when action occurs on hearings, markups, new amendments, added cosponsors and much more. This service includes the ability to create custom bill reports to summarize the trajectory of the legislation most important to you and is searchable and alertable by: keyword, bill number, committee, subcommittee, sponsor, co-sponsor, chamber, legislative stage, appropriations bill and more. An archive of content is available since the 99th Congress (1985).

House Action Reports

Detailed Legislative Reports. Forward Looking. Summaries and Analysis.

Originally designed exclusively for the House of Representatives, House Action Reports is a unique service that delivers five distinct legislative reports:

Legislative Day

Forward looking projection of what's going to happen on the House floor the following day. Provides a listing of amendments and motions that are expected to be offered.

Legislative Week

Published on Friday evening, this report provides summaries and analysis of every bill scheduled for floor consideration for the upcoming week. Supplements are published throughout the week as legislation is added to the schedule or when additional information becomes available.

Fact Sheets

Provided for key pieces of legislation, these reports offer a detailed summary of the entire bill before floor debate including background information, cost estimates, fact tables and more.

Floor Summaries

These detailed reports describe the changes made on the House floor to key legislation.

Conference Summaries

Describes the version of key legislation agreed upon by House and Senate conferees—with details provided shortly after the release of the conference report.

All reports are searchable and alertable by keyword, bill number, report type, appropriation bills and more with an archive of content since the 106th Congress (1999).

Bill Analysis

Expert Synopsis. Detailed Breakdowns. Bill Outlook.

This service delivers summaries and analyses of major bills before Congress, including background information and prospects for passage—reports are updated after major action occurs in committee or on the floor. You can make up to six custom requests per year to have our staff analyze bills not planned for universal coverage. The service is searchable and alertable with an archive of content since the 104th Congress (1995).

Committee Coverage

Enhanced Government Documents

Full-Text. Searchable. Alertable.

Bill Text

Includes a database of every bill and the various versions of each with links to PDFs from the GPO website. An archive is available since the 100th Congress (1987).

Amendment Text

Delivers the full-text of committee and floor amendments – often before they have been acted on. Links to introduced amendments are integrated with the BillTrack and Committee Coverage services.

Committee Reports

Offers the full text of every committee report dating back to the 101st Congress (1989). We convert committee report tables to HTML format, so you can search and receive alerts on specific line-items and earmarks. (Reports are also available in PDF).

Federal Register

Access the official daily publication for the rules, proposed rules and notices of federal agencies, as well as executive orders and other presidential documents. An archive is available since the 101st Congress (1990).

Committee Testimony

Access prepared witness statements as submitted to committees and subcommittees. View the full document of all testimony submitted or use the table of contents to jump directly to an individual witness statement. An archive is available since the 104th Congress (1995).

Congressional Record

Access the official record of the proceedings and debates of Congress. This online version is updated daily and includes an archive since the 100th Congress (1987) with a hyperlinked table of contents for each entry.

CRS Bill Digest

Offers the official synopsis of legislation, with links to related news, analysis and source material, prepared by the Congressional Research Service.

Public Law Text

Dating back to the 106th Congress (1999), this service offers the complete text of all laws enacted, including all margin notes and Statute cites.

U.S. Code

The official compilation of federal laws, organized by subject matter into 51 “Titles.” Delivers the most current version of the U.S. Code, updating each section as new laws are passed that modify it.

Bill Compare

Track the differences in language between Bill Text documents and compare the wording found in two versions of the same bill, in two different bills or in selected sections of any two bill versions. **Requires access to Bill Text.**

Custom Vote Reports

Choose any set of votes back to 1991, and any set of members in the House or Senate, and quickly pull together reports showing the positions of those members on those votes. This tool allows you to see the patterns and breakdowns of how members voted compared to each other and the party line. **Requires access to Floor Votes.**

Law Track

Links the text of a bill to the section of the public law and U.S. Code it would modify should that bill be enacted into law. You can receive email alerts to let you know when bills are introduced that might affect the laws you monitor helping you to discover other bills in Congress that would change the same law.

Custom Email Alerts
